- graziers interested in trialling other technologies.

The project features:



- walk-over-weighting technology to study the relationship between weekly cattle weights against pasture greenness and groundcover
- the management decisions associated with that relationship
- the impact of those decisions on the whole business through the FarmECCO business analysis platform
- trialling technologies that are relevant to the grazing industry and the project's outcomes.
